Read Petition of Robert A. Morad, Thomas Meredith, Jeremiah Muzeroll and James Tushee - stating that they had paid into the Hands of Mr. Lockwood the Fees for their Grants which had never been paid over by him, in consequence of which their Grants had not been ~~processed~~ - and it appearing from the statement of the Hon^{ble} Mr. Shore the acting Surveyor General that Mr. Lockwood had acknowledged the fact above stated Ordered that Mr. Shore do pay over to the respective Offices their proportions of the Fees lodged, as above stated, and charge the same against ^{Mr. Lockwood's proportion of} the moluments of the Surveyor General's Office

Ordered that a Reserve be made for the use of the ^{Indians} on the north side of Richibucto River, extending from the upper line of the Grant to William Harley opposite to Paul Island to the lower line of Reserve No. 9. opposite ^{Island and to} include two miles to the rear from the River - saving the Reserves already made for the use of the Crown -

Ordered the following additional Regulations respecting Timber Licences be adopted and forthwith published -
